### **TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS**

29<sup>th</sup> October, 2021

#### **To All Air Transport Operators**

I refer to the Transitional Arrangements made on the 20<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 by the then Director General, Mr. Michael F. L. Allen, which (amongst other things) indicated that manuals approved by the CAA-B would remain valid until 30 September 2021.

Due to the recent staff changes within the CAA-B and the ongoing effects of the COVID 19 pandemic, the requirement for manuals to be amended to reflect the new civil aviation regulations will now be extended until 1<sup>st</sup> February 2022.

Air Transport Operators are still required to submit their amended manuals for approval in accordance with the applicable CAR at least sixty (60) days prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2022.
