



**NOTICE TO ALL AIRMAN AND AIR OPERATORS LICENSED UNDER THE CIVIL
AVIATION ACT 2021**

VARIATION OF GENERAL EXEMPTION

**(FURTHER EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO PASS THE BAHAMAS
AIR LAW EXAM)**

On October 11, 2024, the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority Bahamas (CAA-B) issued a General Exemption exempting all holders of CAA-B-issued licenses and certificates from the requirement to demonstrate knowledge of Bahamian Air Law by passing The Bahamas Air Law Exam (“the Exam”), as stipulated under Civil Aviation Regulations CAR LIC.075, CAR LIC.215(a), CAR LIC.220(a), CAR LIC.310(a), CAR LIC.515(c), and CAR LIC.615(b).

Subsequently, on January 15, 2025, a Variation of the General Exemption was issued, extending the deadline for compliance with the Exam requirement to June 30, 2025.

This current Variation further extends the compliance deadline to **December 31, 2025**.

Exemption

Pursuant to the authority granted under Section 18(1) of the Civil Aviation Authority Bahamas Act, 2021, the Director General hereby issues a general exemption to all individuals holding CAA-B-issued licenses and certificates, for whom the CAA-B is the Competent Authority. These individuals are exempt from the requirement to demonstrate knowledge by passing the Exam, as required under the Civil Aviation Regulations.

Extension

This exemption extends the deadline for passing the Exam from June 30, 2025, to **December 31, 2025**.
