Statement on Aircraft Accident at North Bimini Seaplane Base

The Civil Aviation Authority Bahamas (CAA-B) confirms that it has been notified of an aircraft accident involving a Cessna 208B bearing United States registration N388TA at the North Bimini Seaplane Base, North Bimini, Bimini, Bahamas, this morning at approximately 10:00 a.m.

The Aircraft Accident Investigation Authority (AAIA) has commenced a safety investigation in accordance with international standards.

While the aircraft falls under the oversight of the United States as the State of Registry, CAA-B is conducting a parallel regulatory review to assess the operator's compliance with the conditions of its Air Transport Licence and other applicable Bahamian civil aviation regulatory requirements governing its operations within The Bahamas.

At this time, no further details are available. Updates will be provided as confirmed information becomes available. Our thoughts are with those affected.
